Minutes: The 12/4/2018 minutes were approved unanimously.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: The 2019 Budget as presented was adopted. Copies of The End of The Year Treasurer's Report were made available.

President Josh Kline opened the meeting and welcomed all in attendance. Josh gave a brief introduction of board members and spoke on some of the highlights of the year including repair of our entrance sign, installation of bollards at the beach gate, security cameras installed at both gates, irrigation improvements, as well as, normal maintenance issues.

Josh invited comments from the assembly. Nick Binder asked the board to consider replacing the damaged Bollard at the beach gate, to add another "no truck" sign at the beach entrance, raising the builders bond to \$5,000, and sending a notice to residents reminding them that short term (less than 7 months) rental of homes in Whispering Oaks is not allowed .
